Here are the activities that the **Physics Society** are involved in:

- **Monday 19 September.** 10.10am, 2nd Floor Concourse, Newton.
Meet & Join the Physics Society.

 - 1) Progressed FY are taken by a SUPS rep straight down to the computing lab, Newton 141, to:
